Please see the parent letter issued on Thursday 10th September, which explains what we have now put in place following an increase last academic year in the number of children being regularly collected after the gates have closed at the end of the school day.

We will no longer be able to allow adults collecting late, onsite at the end of the day as this is compromising the safe loading and departure of school transport.
