As you'll be aware, the governors and leaders of the school agreed, following appropriate consultation with key stakeholders including parents and carers that becoming a self converted Academy would provide an excellent platform to continue delivering effective teaching and learning.

We are very pleased to tell you that as of today, **1<sup>st</sup> May 2013**, we have converted to an Academy.

The managing body of the Academy is called Charville Primary School Academy Trust and is a registered company in England and Wales.

Beyond this, there is very little visible change and has no impact on teaching and learning.

- We are the **same** school with the **same** school day timings, uniform AND the **same** name
