ATTENDANCE REWARDS



As a school we have discussed the ways in which we reward pupils for regular attendance with pupils, parents/carers and staff to gather feedback.

Going forward it has been agreed that the following rewards will be used:-

- Weekly non uniform for classes with attendance over 99%
- The first day of each new term will be a non-uniform day for pupils who had 100% attendance the previous term
- Termly attendance certificates
- In the summer term children with 100% attendance will be rewarded with an in school activity afternoon to be arranged.

Nursery pupils will continue to receive weekly and termly attendance certificates.
